ATTENDED FUNERAL (Funeral Director's charges only)	£1935.00
This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend the burial or cremation	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 20 miles of the Funeral Director's premises) into the Funeral Director's care Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities.
